Rules 7v7, 11v11 Youth & Adults





- 1. Monetary game Referee fees, cedulas (Player Roster Form), and league credentials or permission slips must be turned in at the beginning of the game. Home side if first come and visitors opposite side.
- 2. Permission slip is required for any new team; permitted only for the first 2 games (all players must present an ID with their permission, which will be returned at the end of the game). All new teams must be fully registered before the start of their third league game.
- **3. Uniforms**: All team members Shirts/Jerseys and shorts must all match in color, including stripes. Sweaters and pants under uniform is ok. Have 1 sets of uniform and 1 set of bids required with numbers not repeated with no exceptions.
- 4. Reports: All reports of uniforms, Age, Credentials, List Templates, unprovided team soccer ball at start of game, and non-registered (Cachirules) or suspended players Etc. will have a \$10 fee (\$20 in plaoffs) to formalize the report. <u>Uniform Report</u>: Socks, color numbers, and logos are not applicable. Time Tardy Report: Is not payable under no circumstance, and such report will be handled by the league board and any proof by Tuesdays. Result of report will be 2-0 and 1-0 in playoff.
- 5. Any team that refuses to play their game, will lose 2 points in the team standings, pay a double referee fee, and lose their scheduled game by the score of 5 to 0.
- 6. The maximum waiting time period for all games is 5 minutes from their official scheduled time. Example: If a game is scheduled at 7:00pm they have till 7:05pm to step on the field. The team that is present ready to play reports at the beginning to referee before game starts about team enter after 6minutes and report is valid, will win that game by a score of 5 to 0. YES, GAMES CONTINUES!
- 7. Any Team that does not show up, without prior approved cancelation, or cancels on same day as game, OR DON'T HAVE ENOUGH PLAYERS, will lose the game 5-0 and be responsible to pay the amount plus half of referee fee. The team present only pays half. IN PLAYOFFS LOOSE 1-0, BUT SECOND ROUND AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFY.
- 8. Any game cancelled after put on Spond App will lose the game, 2-0 and penalty of half referee fee.
- All players, coaches/trainers and fans must all follow the local code of conduct state laws. (VERY STRICT ON SYNTHETIC/TURF FIELDS!!)
- 7v7 games have a duration of 40 minutes (Two 20-minute halves). 11v11 games have a duration of 1hour (Two 28-minute halves).
- 11. Most game matches begin from 6pm on weekdays and 4pm on weekends. It is recommended that each team has 2 coaches in case of any emergency.
- 12. Goal keep cannot pick up the ball with his hands if directly passed by his own teammate.
- 13. All game wins are 3 points, Ties are 1 point, and loss 0 points. In playoff the standing don't count go straight to elimination.
- 14. Throw-ins are to be played with hands.
- 15. Players can enter and exit any game, there are no substitution restrictions. They must notify the referee before making any substitution and receive prior permission on a stopped ball before making the official substitution.





- 16. Individual Player permits are \$5 (children in I.D. sign with proof of age). Player & Coaches League Credentials are: \$30 Youth (\$15-\$20 Adult) (if player provides 2 photos), \$35 Youth (\$20-\$25 Adult) (if players need League to take a photo for them). Player can change team one time a season if the coach gives up his card, if they don't, they have to wait 2 weeks to register with new team. Can't play in 2 teams same division, can play higher division same club. 2 registered coaches in case of any emergency.
- 17. Coaches, Players and non-registered (Cachirul) are suspended will be fined \$25 and suspended. Second violation will be \$50 and suspension. The third violation will be a \$100 fine and suspended for 1 year.
- 18. All teams must have a minimum of 4 (7v7) and 7 (11v11) players registered. It is recommended that all teams have lists with all players ready to avoid wasting time.
- 19. The championship finals will not require teams to provide cedulas (Player Roster Form). The only players allowed to participate in any final/championship game will be from a list provided by the league's office registration form. Coaches are allowed to review all credentials before the final game, if any player is not on the list, they will not be allowed to play in the final.
- 20. Playoffs: Any official paid report, reviewed by the league board regarding any team violation that occurs in the 2nd leg or game, can result in a team elimination.
- 21. Last day of registering players will be two weeks before playoffs so the new player can play.
- 22. Coaches are responsible for keeping team areas clean after every game or you will be fined \$25.
- 23. If you are in the first match or the last of the day, all teams must be responsible to place your goals in your designated field, or collecting area (end of game) or you will be fined \$25 Thank you.
- 24. Player who receives a yellow card will have to leave the field for 3 min (7v7 with substitution) and (11v11 with substitution) without exception. On 7v7, any Goalkeeper who receives a yellow does not leave, only field player must step off or a substitution can enter.
- 25. No players or fans are allowed behind the goals. This is to avoid problems.
- 26. Coaches are responsible for players and fans actions, tell them about our RULES: No insults, only coach can kindly talk to referee, no food, chewing gum and drinks, only water is permitted on synthetic/turf fields (City Rules). Videos and pictures can be provided to sanction.
- 27. Registering under-age Children: Parent or legal guardian must provide 2 photos, a copy of Birth Certificate, California ID or Passport. Any child who is reported, must provide physical proof of original documentation.
- 28. Meeting is the last Tuesday of the month. Not attending lose -2 points.
- 29. Permits are not allowed to be used in finals.
- **30.** Youth- all Girls teams can be 2 years older, Co-Ed girls can be 1 year older, up to 15 years. Any older than 15 must play with adult women.
- 31. In the end, if there is a result that is suspended and no prize is decided at the table. (Open Suspension and Fine.)
